Team Benches

The teams would collect food/money for the Dufferin County Food Bank during their times. The teams would go drop the food off at the food bank and then they would get a food receipt to take to their team manager. Posters, handouts and supply list of needed products will be dropped off with the OMH to pass out to teams. The prizes for the competition are 1st place- private practice with the Brampton Battalion coach and box at a Brampton Battalion game. The prizes for 2nd, 3rd, 4th place are practice with former NHLer. There will be a prize awarded to the top team who collects the most food.
