Competitive Programming (Rep):

Tryout schedules, fees and rules will be finalized by September for U13 and Below and posted on our website soon.

Our tryout format for 2022 will consist of the following:

U14 and Above:

- Tryouts closed teams selected May 2022
- Development Phase begins September 6, 2022
- Tournaments may begin September 30, 2022
- Regular Season planned to start Oct 11, 2022 (32 games)

Prep Skates: U8/U9/U11/U13

Player pathways require 4 prep skates to be provided by the organization prior to the evaluation of players. These skates will be offered by OMH but are not mandatory to attend and will consist of four sessions at cost of \$50.00 stay tuned for registration dates and details!

U10/U11/U12/U13 Tryouts:

- Prep Skates begin week of September 6, 2022
- AAA tryouts begin September 10, 2022
- AA tryouts begin September 17, 2022 (Development Phase starts 09/19/2022)
- A tryouts begin September 24, 2022 (Development Phase starts 09/26/2022)
- Tournaments may begin October 7, 2022, Regular Season starts Oct 11, 2022 (28 games)

Requirement for 4 prep phase skates prior to evaluation skates is mandated by OHF and player pathway for U13 and below. Prep Skates will be offered **between September 6, 2022-September 16, 2022**

U9/U8 MD:

Note for this season only U9/U8 will compete in the Tri-County MD program and tiered by like skill (ie MD 1 = AA & MD2= A) as approved for 2022/2023 by OMHA.

- Prep Phase begin week of **September 6, 2022**
- Grass roots goalie development program with Blue Ice Goaltending
- Players interested in the travel program will be selected based on evaluations
- Tri-county planning on 22 game season with 12 half ice games Nov 1 to Jan 15th, 2022, and 10 Full Ice games starting January 16th, 2023
- If there is interest, we will offer a second U9MD (formally AE) & U8MD program based on registration support
- Coaching selections for U9MD Tier 2 & U8MD will be finalized once prep skates/evaluations are underway
