House League Updates

Initiation: We have been contacted by 4 people interested in the Initiation Director position: Jaime Swainson, Paul Comi, Michael Hackett & Heather MacArthur.

Each of their emails to OMH are read out and discussed, the board votes and the new Initiation Director is Jaime Swainson.

Scott has spoken to Craig Nelson and he has agreed to help out with this division by developing and coaching the coaches.

Minor Tyke: Cannot have a Super 6 team, can however have a Rostered Select team. Coaches will have to do everything themselves and the team cannot interfere with house league.

An OMH panel will pick the team and then pick a coach. Tryouts will be posted shortly on the OMH website (Rick to find some ice time for the tryouts) cost will be \$20/tryout (to cover the cost of the ice). Will also post for coaches, link on website to submit applications.

Tyke/Novice: no issues

Atom: There will be a rostered select team (2006 & 2007) as well (see above for Minor Tyke as they will both be posted at the same time and tryouts and coach selection done the same way).

Peewee: Girls playing peewee and above must change in their own dressing rooms. Also, no women in the dressing starting at peewee.

Bantam: no issues

Midget: A minor midget goalie has quit; was not comfortable playing against and taking shots from 19 year olds.

A dad has asked if his two boys could split one spot. The boys have grown up playing in OMH but they also play basketball so the dad has proposed that they share one spot and pay one registration. The executive declined this request as it creates an issue with insurance and could potentially create other issues in the future, such as both boys wanting to play on the day of champs.

Directors are advised that any shifting of players must be done by Halloween and Joanne notified of the changes so she can amend the rosters.

Rep Update

There have been issues with with players not wearing full equipment during practices. Terry will send out a reminder.

Suspensions need to be reported to Terry as soon as possible. Managers will be reminded.

Peter advises that Scott is looking for 3 hours of ice time the last Saturday of each month to run goalie development. Would be looking at having 15 kids @ \$25 each to cover costs.

Jersey Issues

-Sizing issues for Novice AE team

-Sponsor Bars - it wasn't clear that they weren't included (they have been in the past) and the ones they did were done incorrectly. Natasha advised that the sponsor bars likely won't be included next year. Bauer are not honouring our order or our contract.

-Bantam AE team's order has many errors, missing jerseys, mismatched numbers, no name bars on some, sponsor bars all mixed up. Problem jerseys were sent back to Bauer with a list of issues sponsor bars were fixed but nothing else. We have asked for the numbers and sponsor bars to be sent to Josh at Sanderson Sports and he will have Archibolds put them on the jerseys. Natasha is going to ask Bauer to do something for this team because of all the jersey issues.

- Bauer has no extra black jerseys. If a black jersey has to be cut off of a player due to injury it will take approximately 70 days to get a replacement. This is bad business given we have a 3 year contract.

-On the jersey order forms there was a spot to indicate C (captain) and A (assistant) and some coaches did indicate this on the forms, however they did not come with the letters on the jerseys.

Ice time

The Town of Orangeville has to be notified of all cancelled ice time by October 8 for the remainder of the regular season. Huge issue to try and keep some extra ice just in case there are issues.

IN CAMERA

Rules

Goalies - Pee wee and below: A rostered goalie can't play out, but if your goalie gets hurt a rostered or an AP player can play goal. They will have 5 minutes to get dressed and must be wearing full goalie equipment to play in goal.

Two deep dressing room rule: there is a 2 deep rule which means there is to be either 2 approved bench staff or one approved bench staff and one adult in the dressing room at all times.

On ice helpers (from the OMHA Manual of Operations): Anyone helping on ice must wear a CSA approved helmet. Under 16 years of age, must wear full equipment, over 16 same equipment as an official or coach. Players can be on ice helpers as of the age of 9 and must be 2 years older than the players they are assisting. From 9-14 must be rostered to an OMHA team and over 14 must have their Respect in Sport.

AP Player Costs

Have been required to pay \$10 to AP from House League to rep. It is suggested that we not charge this fee any longer in order to encourage development. It is also a bit tedious to collect and account for the fees.

Terry motions to no longer charge AP players a fee to practice or play with rep. or Intra City teams, Peter 2nds, motion carried.

Atom update (part 2)

Rick asks Cheryl if she has anything to add regarding any Atom issues and she is brought up to speed on what was decided in regards to the Atom Select Team and the tryouts and coach selection. She advised that she has received numerous emails from Atom parents asking if there is going to be an Atom Select team.

Cheryl says she has 6 goalies for 4 teams (3 major and 3 minor). 2 teams have goalies playing half games as none of them want to play out. There were 8 goalies but one is playing out now and one went to Erin. A suggestion was made that if a team that only has one goalie is going to be missing their goalie that they have one of the goalies from a team with 2 goalies play with them for that game.

Terry motions to adjourn the meeting, Peter seconds, meeting adjourned at 8:49pm.
